



Response to COVID-19

- Career Resource Centers and Youth programs providing virtual services
- Offering a suite of live and archived webinars for employment assistance
- Expanding online enrollment options
- Enhanced customer website for all metro Atlanta customer: ATLworks.org
- Critical projects continue to advance, including:
 - Local and Regional Workforce Plans
 - One-Stop MOU
 - Provider Contracts
 - Board and Career Centers Certifications





Workforce Funding

- PY2019 training funds expended quicker than anticipated
- PY2020 funding allocations reduced by 16%
- Stimulus Funds Opportunities
 - Dislocated Worker NEG Award \$1.1 million
 - RAWA and HEREOS legislation included significant workforce funds
- Support additional funding requests and consider options to leverage funds



Remainder of the Year

- Prepare plans for re-opening programs to inperson services
- Transition additional services to virtual platforms
- Regional collaborations continue
- Prepare outreach and program designs to support COVID-19 impacted workers and businesses
